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Notification of Intent to Install Satellite Dish Antenna

Before Installing a Dish Antenna, please note:

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- According to FCC Rule, Section 1.400000 of Title 47, the Association may restrict the installation of any Dish Antenna on common area, such as exterior walls and any portion of the roof. The Association may also prohibit the drilling of holes through a common element, such as exterior walls or any element of the roof.
- 2. By completing this form, you agree not to install a Dish Antenna until an Association representative has performed an inspection to determine where and how the Dish may be installed.
- 3. At the time of this inspection you will be informed where the Dish Antenna may be installed.
- 4. Within ten days following the installation, you must notify the Association that the installation is complete. An Association representative will inspect to ensure proper installation. If the results of this inspection are satisfactory, a signed approval will be forwarded.

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Installation of Satellite Dish Antenna

In establishing restrictions regarding the installation of Dish Antennas, it is not the intent of the Association to prohibit them, but rather to provide an orderly method and Homeowner and values of property held in common,

The FCC has promulgated extensive rules regarding this issue; "over-the-air reception devises rule" 47 C.F.R. Section 1.4000, some sections of which are extracted below:

"The Rule allows Community Association to enforce restrictions that do not impair installation of Dish Antennas. In addition, the rule <u>does not</u> apply to common areas owned by the Association. Such common areas may include the roof or exterior wall of a unit. Therefore, restrictions on antennas installed in or on such common areas are enforceable."

"The Rule <u>does not</u> permit you to install all antenna on a common area, such as an exterior wall or the roof. However, you may install an antenna wholly within a patio or other area where you have exclusive use."

"The commission's Rules <u>does not</u> cover installations if you drill through an exterior wall, because the exterior wall is a common element."

Based upon the above provision of the FCC Rule, The BGHOAI has implemented an "intent to install" procedure to assist the Homeowner in the proper and acceptable installation of a Satellite Dish Antenna.

Because the Association believes it has the legal right to enforce it's *"intent to install"*Procedure, failure to follow it may result in legal action requiring that the Dish Antenna be removed, at the cost, and compliance with procedure.
